Joinder Declaration

on the proceedings before the Unabhängige Kommission (Independent Commission) SKKG
(hereafter: UK-SKKG)

The UK-SKKG has decided to initiate proceedings with regard to the following work:

1. The undersigned confirm that they are aware that the UK-SKKG opened proceedings on [date] focusing on the aforementioned work, and that they are to be involved in these proceedings.

3. By signing this joinder declaration, the undersigned Claimants and/or their authorized representatives confirm that they have taken note of the Rules of Procedure of the UK-SKKG and declare they agree with its integral content.
4. The undersigned take particular note of the publication of the results of the proceedings, the reports, the relevant sources and other documents, as well as the provenance of the cultural good resulting from the proceedings, and expressly declare they consent to said publication. Personal information and other data worthy of protection will be anonymized at the request of the parties to the proceedings.
5. In particular, the undersigned agree to treat all information during the proceedings as confidential. If the undersigned assume the function of a legal representative of any Claimants, they agree to require their clients to maintain said confidentiality.
6. The UK-SKKG will inform the Stiftung für Kunst, Kultur und Geschichte (Foundation of Arts, Culture and History) (hereafter: SKKG) as a participant in the proceedings about this joinder declaration, as soon as the signed document has been received by the UK-SKKG.
